1 Decide

Weeks 1–2

- AI discussed at a formal partners'/team meeting (*not a corridor conversation*)
- Business case presented: specific problem being solved
- Concerns raised and documented
- Clear decision recorded in minutes: proceeding / not proceeding / need more info
- AI lead appointed
- Timeline agreed

2 Prepare

Weeks 3–6

- Clinical lead and administrative lead identified
- Tool evaluated using five-question framework (*Module 3*)
- Tool confirmed on AVT Registry
- Single tool selected (*not trialling multiple simultaneously*)
- DPIA completed
- ICO registration reviewed and updated if needed
- Caldicott Guardian review and approval obtained
- Patient communication materials drafted (*waiting room notices, website, verbal consent script*)

3 Pilot

Weeks 7–12

- Two to three pilot clinicians selected (*mix of enthusiast, pragmatist, cautious*)
- Pilot duration set (*four to six weeks*)
- Baseline documentation times measured (*one week pre-pilot*)
- Error logging process in place
- Patient consent process tested and working
- Pilot data collected: time, quality, experience
- Patient opt-out rate tracked
- Pilot results evaluated and presented to team

- All clinicians trained (*tool mechanics, note review, consent, when to pause, error reporting, governance*)
- Non-clinical staff briefed
- Documentation policy updated
- Patient information updated
- Consent processes formalised
- Clinical governance reporting updated
- Three-month review date set
- Six-month review date set
